- FM/Sustainability Update
 - Sustainability Website
 - The Office of Sustainability is in the process of updating and redesigning the sustainability website.
 - The location of all ink cartridge and water bottle refilling station location will be made available on the website when completed.

 - There will be a page linked to the site that will provide opportunity for students, staff and faculty to submit project ideas to the Sustainability Office.

o RecycleMania

- RecycleMania is in full swing.
- This is an international recycling competition that includes submitting recycling weight information every week until April 1st.
- The result of this competition will provide a per capita recycle rate for UTD and earning a rank among many other universities across the United States and other countries.

Tree Campus USA

- UT Dallas is an official Tree Campus USA campus for 2016.
- This required the establishment of a campus tree advisory committee, tree care plan, campus tree program with annual expenditures, Arbor Day observance, and service learning projects.

o Eco Rep Program

- The Office of Sustainability within Facilities Management has initiated the Eco-Reps Program.
- This includes the hiring of five additional interns to enhance campus sustainability awareness and initiatives across campus.
- Current projects for the new Eco-Reps include the following:
 - Event and activity planning
 - Vermicomposting
 - Sustainability themed graphic design
 - Learning operational processes
 - Weekly team meetings
 - Recyclemania game day planning at athletic event
 - Bee hive installation planning

Water Bottle Refilling Station

- The water bottle refilling stations offer free chilled water refills for students, staff and faculty at UT Dallas.
- Each station keeps track of how many 16-ounce bottles have been diverted from a landfill.
- As of the end of January, UT Dallas has diverted over 1.2 million 16-ounce bottles from a landfill.
- Earth Week Academic Event
 - There is confidence that there will be an academic panel similar to last years.
 - Brett Cease has volunteered to help organize and plan the academic panel during earth week. As of current, the Sustainability Committee will assist in identifying faculty whom would be able to participate on the panel.
 - There is a deadline of March 6th to send all information (Date, Time and Location) of events and activities during Earth Week to The Office of Student Volunteerism for marketing support.

Discussion

- \$8000 will be available for environmental projects (Green Initiative) from the Student Service Fee. This is for the next academic year.
