- Minutes approval
 - No minutes to approve
- Facilities Management/Sustainability Office
 - Move In (August 16-19)
 - In partnership with Housing, Facilities Management setup 7 cardboard collection pens around campus housing locations
 - The FM teams separated cardboard, plastic film and Styrofoam #6
 - Over 7900 lbs. of cardboard was recycled
 - Over 60 lbs. of plastic film was recycled
 - Over 70 lbs. of Styrofoam #6 was recycled
 - Organix Recycling
 - New changes to the compost program are taking place through the partnership with a composting and landscape waste management company called Organix Recycling
 - Facilities Management will no longer be picking up the pre-consumer food waste containers from DHW, PS3 and SU
 - Organix Recycling has installed 2, 2 YD. containers and 3 large rolling toters at the collection locations
 - On a scheduled pickup, Organix will have a truck empty and rinse the containers. From there, they will transport the food waste to their facility in Hutchins Texas
 - [Organix Recycling](#) accepts more food waste materials than our in-house operation
 - This program opens the door for increased food waste collection in the future.
 - Eco-Reps 2017
 - There is a planning meeting on September 6th for the Eco-Reps

- One of the key areas of focus for this semester will be outreach to the campus community to spread the sustainability message
 - AASHE STARS – planning for 2018
 - The goal is to submit a new STARS report before the end of the summer; preferably have all the new information by April
 - Evan will be coordinating with offices and departments across campus to gather and collect information to submit in the report
- Sustainability during the Semester
 - Webinars ([CURC](#) & [AASHE](#))
 - Free webinars are available through the College and University Recycling Coalition and the Association for the Advancement of Sustainability in Higher Education
 - These are open to the public and as UT Dallas is an AASHE member, students, staff and faculty have access to the available webinars
 - The sustainability webinars are online presentations and training opportunities to learn more about sustainability in specific subject areas
 - All you need is access to the internet and audio to listen in
 - Preparedness Fair (Sept. 28)
 - The Environmental Health & Safety Office is hosting a preparedness fair that includes tabling and raising awareness of a variety of safety, emergency and health related resources
 - The Texas Arbor Day (Nov. 3)

 - Texas Recycles Day (Nov. 15)
 - There is interest in pushing for a recycling event for this day including the initiative to enhance awareness of confidential paper shredding and Styrofoam #6 and packing peanut recycling
