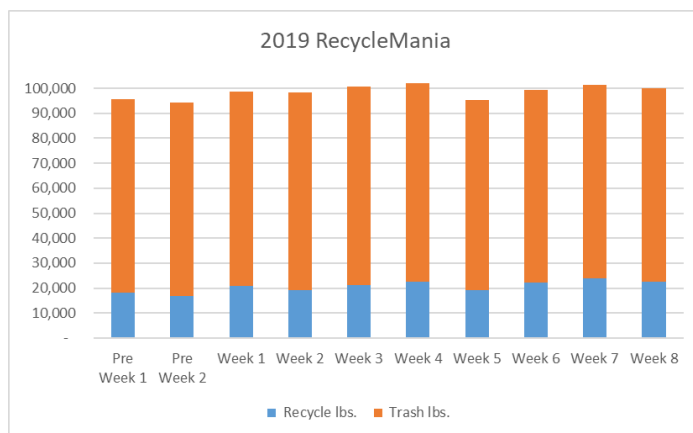


Figure 1 Trash and Recycling for RecycleMania 2019. Over 207,000 lbs. of material was recycled during RecycleMania
