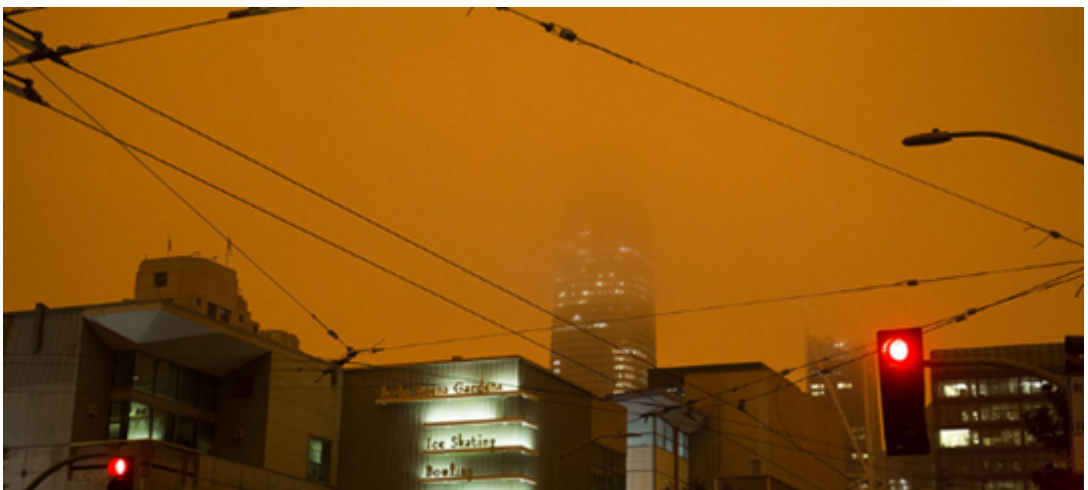

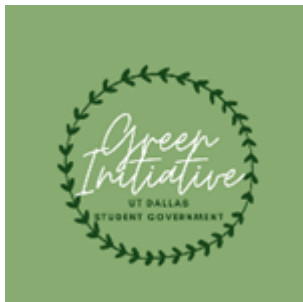
Green Work Spaces: At Home and in the Office
